

# pedal people recycling, trash & compost

## paper & cardboard



Clean papers, magazines/catalogs, gift wrap/bags/tissue paper and greeting cards (no metallic inks, foil, glitter, batteries), paperback books (covers ok), paperboard, empty pizza boxes. Paper clips, staples and metal spirals are ok. Flatten & leave cardboard beside bins.

## containers



Metal cans, foil, milk and juice cartons, glass bottles and jars, plastic bottles/jars/tubs/jugs, clear plastic hinged containers (clamshells), clear plastic egg cartons, clear plastic cups (no lids or straws). Empty and clean all containers. Lids & caps must be on containers (not loose).

## compost



All food scraps, including meat and dairy (no liquids), non-recyclable paper and cardboard with no plastic content or metal wire, and BPI certified plastic compostable products: cutlery, cups, food waste bags, to-go containers. See reverse for more.

## trash



In closed bags, each one weighing 30 pounds or less.

## trash

We charge for trash by weight (pounds) or volume (gallons), whichever is greater. Additional trash is \$4 per 10 gallons or pounds, if we have space. For example, if you pay for 30 gallon service and we take 40 gallons or pounds, we charge \$4 extra.

## recycling

Separate as shown on the opposite side. For weekly pickups, we'll take a maximum of four 14-gallon tubs (which we provide) of recycling per pickup. For biweekly or monthly pickups, the maximum is three 14-gallon tubs. Additional recycling is \$4 per 14-gallon tub, if we have space.

## compost

Put in a closed container lined with a paper bag, newspaper, or a certified compostable plastic bag such as BioBags. Please clean your container regularly. All plans include up to 10 gallons of compost per pickup. Extra is \$0.25 per pound if we have room (free if you have trash pickup and haven't reached the maximum trash weight of your plan).

## billing

We bill in advance, in 3 or 6 month periods. For the first pickup, we'll start right away, and you'll have 30 days to pay. Bartering arrangements and financial assistance are possible.

## other items (separated)

- **Books** – in a separate bag, marked.
- **Clothes, rags, textiles and shoes** – in closed bags and labeled.
- **Scrap metal** – small items. Heavy items or large quantities by arrangement only and for an extra charge.
- **Christmas trees** – \$15 to \$25, depending on size. By arrangement.
- **Fluorescent bulbs and tubes** – carefully packaged and labeled, by arrangement. Small extra charge applies.
- **Yard waste** – by arrangement.

## pickup time & postponement

Everything must be out by 8 a.m. on your pickup day, and will be picked up by 5 p.m.

In the event of a major storm, we'll e-mail or call you to inform you of a postponement as soon as we know.

If your pickup day falls on the following holidays, it will be postponed one day unless we notify you otherwise: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, 4th of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas.
